Official public notice is hereby given that the City of Bessemer will receive sealed bids for the bid of the

**BESSEMER CDBG STREET RESURFACING PROJECT ALONG PARTS OF 7TH ST N, 18TH AVE, 24TH ST N,  
7TH AVE N, 6TH AVE N, AND WILLOWBROOK DRIVE NEIGHBORHOOD**

Bids will be opened and read aloud on **Wednesday, January 11, 2023** at **10:00 a.m.** at **Bessemer City Hall – Multipurpose Room – 1700 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue North Bessemer, AL 35020.**

Deadline for submitting bids is **Wednesday, January 11, 2023** at **9:00 a.m.** to EEFS Company, PC 1930 2<sup>nd</sup> Ave N, Suite 150, Bessemer, Alabama 35020.

**There will not be a pre-bid meeting for this project. All bidders must have a current Alabama General Contractors license and shall be qualified for the type of work specified.**

Bids MUST be submitted directly to the office of the City Engineer. Bids will be accepted prior to the date of opening of bids at the office of the City Engineer from 7:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m., Monday through Thursday or mailed to EEFS Company, PC. Each bid must be sealed and the following words must appear on the outside of the sealed envelope:

The Information for Bidders, Form of Bid, Form of Contract, Plans, Specifications, and Form of Bid Bond, Performance and Payment Bond, and other contract documents may be examined at the following location: EEFS Company, PC 1930 2<sup>nd</sup> Ave N, Suite 150, Bessemer, AL 35020.

**Scope of Work:** The Bessemer CDBG Resurfacing project along parts of 7<sup>th</sup> Street N, 18<sup>th</sup> Avenue, 24<sup>th</sup> Street N, 7<sup>th</sup> Avenue N, 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue N, and Willowbrook Drive neighborhood consists of the installation of approximately 4,425 tons of bituminous wearing surface overlay (150 – 165 lbs./sq yd thickness) on 6 city street locations. Project includes select partial milling, patching, and leveling of existing pavement as directed by the Engineer, adjustment of underground utility riser tops as needed, installation of traffic striping, markings/legends, pavement markers, and associated traffic control/erosion control. Project also includes replacement of approximately 151 square yards of existing sidewalk and curb ramps to meet current ADA standards for accessible design.

Engineer's Estimate: \$800,000.00

**To submit a bid, a complete set of a bid documents MUST be obtained from EEFS Company, PC.** Bid Documents may be obtained from EEFS Company, PC, the Engineer upon deposit of \$150 per set which will be refunded in full on the first set issued to each general contract bidder submitting a bonafide bid, upon return of documents in good condition within ten days of the bid date. Other sets for general contractors, and sets for subcontractors and dealers, may be obtained with the same deposit, which will be refunded as above, less cost of printing, reproduction, handling, and distribution. Bid Documents must be picked up no later than 24 hours prior to the bid opening.

The owner reserves the right to waive any informalities or to reject any and all bids.

A cashier's check or bid bond payable to City of Bessemer in an amount not less than five (5) percent of the amount of the bid, but in no event more than \$10,000, must accompany the bidder's proposal along with a notarized Non-Collusion Affidavit. A One Hundred Percent (100%) Performance Bond and a One Hundred Percent (100%) Payment Bond and evidence of insurance required in the bid documents will be required at the signing of the Contract.

Attention of bidders is particularly called to the requirements as to conditions of employment to be observed and minimum wage rates to be paid under the contract, Section 3, Segregated Facility, Section 109 and E.O. 11246.

This work falls under the Davis-Bacon Act, as amended (40 U.S.C.276a to a-7) and that contractor shall supply the Community Development Program with certified payroll documentation. The Davis-Bacon and Related Acts will apply to contractors and subcontractors performing construction, alteration, or repair with federally funded or assisted contracts \$2,000 or more. Under this Act, contractors shall be required to pay Wages specified in a wage determination made by the Secretary of Labor. In addition, contractors shall be required to pay wages not less than once a week. A current copy of the prevailing wage can be found at the end of the Supplemental General Conditions section of the bid documents.

Attention of bidders is also called to the Title IX Build America, Buy American section of this bid.
