

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING FOR FISCAL YEAR 2024 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) PUBLIC HEARING

The City of Bessemer Economic and Community Development Department, is preparing to submit the City's anticipated Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) allocation and Annual Action Plan for Fiscal Year 2024 to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD).

The public hearing will be Thursday, February 22nd, 2024, in the Multipurpose Room, 1st Floor, Bessemer City Hall, 1700 Third Avenue North, at 10:00AM and 4:00PM.

The hearing will be in accordance with federal regulations found at 24 CFR 91.105 and the city's Citizen Participation Plan. As an entitlement community and a recipient of CDBG funds, the city is soliciting suggestions, recommendations, ideas, and comments on proposed projects and programs for the City of Bessemer to implement for its Program Year 2024 Annual Action Plan from a cross-section of interested parties including low-to-moderate income persons, residents of public housing, local and regional institution, Continuum of Care, and other agencies such as business, developers, non-profits, philanthropic organizations, and community and faith-based organizations.
